### What is DGTSI?

The Scottish Government embarked on a programme to establish a single Third Sector Interface in each of Scotland's 32 local authority areas. To achieve this they brought together CVS's, Volunteer Centres and social enterprise infrastructure support organisations. Third Sector Interfaces must represent, develop and support volunteering, social enterprises and the wider third sector in their area. They also play the key role in connecting the local the third sector to Community Planning Partnerships.

### What's the "Third Sector"?

The Third sector comprises independent, voluntary or community groups that are not-for-profit organisations. There are approximately 3,000 voluntary and community bodies in Dumfries & Galloway, including 852 registered charities. The Third Sector includes charities, community organisations, housing associations, campaigning organisations, social enterprises, community councils, faith based and religious organisations, sports, arts and environmental groups.
